<b>MAY 1</b>	<u>FIELD PLACEMENT ENDS – Number of Hours Completed</u> <b>First Year</b> – Minimum 240 (spring semester) – Minimum Total 450 <b>Second Year</b> – Minimum 290 (spring semester) – Minimum Total 550 <b>PPSC</b> – Minimum 340 (spring semester) Minimum Total 600
<b>MAY 1</b>	<b>ALL STUDENT EVALUATIONS ARE TO BE SUBMITTED VIA THE IPT ONLINE SYSTEM</b>
<b>MAY 15</b>	Commencement
